- 4. **Current academic transcript(s)** from <u>ALL</u> post-secondary institutions attended. Unofficial transcripts in PDF format from your school's student portal are acceptable.
- **NOT ACCEPTABLE:** Documents submitted in image file format (e.g. jpeg) instead of PDF format Government aid documents that do not display your first and last name
